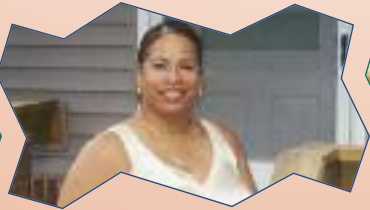

New York Homeownership Program

Randy and Liz Tauscher could only dream about owning a home. Due to a work-related injury, Randy has difficulty walking, especially up and down stairs. So, for 22 years, the Tauschers lived in a two-bedroom apartment that made it easy for Randy to move around. But they wanted more for their daughters, Cathaline, 21, and Caitlin, 11; and dog, Lady. The Tauschers were amazed when they learned that with the help of PathStone's Homeownership Program they could qualify for a USDA-subsidized mortgage and an Acquisition Rehabilitation Grant from New York State Affordable Housing Corp. to make repairs and renovations to accommodate Randy's disability. Today, the Tauschers are living their dream in a 2,400-square-foot home in Clifton Springs. The home even has a master bedroom and bathroom on the first floor and a backyard deck with railings.

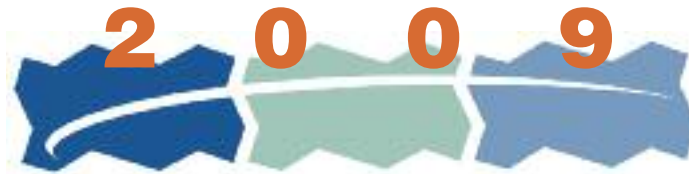
Programa de Titularidad de Hogar en Nueva York

Debido a un accidente relacionado con el trabajo, Randy tiene dificultad para caminar, particularmente para subir y bajar escaleras. Así que los Tauschers vivieron por 22 años en un apartamento de dos habitaciones que le facilitaba a Randy el moverse en la casa. Pero ellos querían más para sus hijas, Cathaline, 21, y Caitlin, 11; y su perro Lady. Los Tauschers estaban asombrados cuando escucharon que con la ayuda del Programa de Titularidad de Hogar de PathStone ellos pudieron calificar para una hipoteca subvencionada por USDA y una Subvención para Rehabilitación de Adquisición de la Corporación de Viviendas Costeables del Estado de Nueva York para hacer reparaciones y renovaciones para adaptar el hogar a la discapacidad de Randy. Ahora, los Tauschers han realizado su sueño viviendo en una casa de 2,400 pies cuadrados en Clifton Springs. La casa tiene un dormitorio principal y un baño en el primer piso y una terraza en el patio de atrás con barandas.

Ohio Homeownership Program

Mario & Maria Hinojosa purchased their home four years ago with a locked mortgage in the small community of Hamler. But soon after, the family began experiencing problems when Mario had to reapply for his work authorization card. Forced to use their life savings, the family fell behind on their mortgage. At the same time, Mario's employer was cutting hours for the winter, and the Hinojosas faced foreclosure. The family fell into a foreclosure scam, and their home was sold. The family contacted PathStone's Foreclosure Prevention Program. PathStone worked to help the family save their home, but it was already in redemption. Then, PathStone referred the family to organizations that could provide them with legal assistance. Granted forbearance, the family was able to keep their home. PathStone provided the Hinojosas with Ohio Rescue funds, which helped keep their mortgage payment low.

Programa de Titularidad de Hogar en Ohio

Hace cuatro años, Mario y María Hinojosa compraron su casa con una hipoteca cerrada en la pequeña comunidad de Hamler. Pero poco tiempo después, la familia comenzó a tener problemas cuando Mario tuvo que solicitar de nuevo su tarjeta de autorización para trabajar. La familia se vio forzada a usar sus ahorros de toda la vida y se atrasó en sus pagos de la hipoteca. A la misma vez, el patrón de Mario estaba reduciendo las horas de trabajo para el invierno y los Hinojosas se vieron amenazados con la ejecución hipotecaria. La familia cayó en una estafa de ejecución hipotecaria y su casa fue vendida. La familia contactó el Programa de Prevención de Ejecución de Hipoteca de PathStone. PathStone trabajó con la familia para salvar su casa, pero ya estaba en redención. Entonces, PathStone envió a la familia a organizaciones que podían proveer ayuda legal. Gracias a la paciencia, la familia pudo retener su casa. PathStone proveyó los fondos de Rescate de Ohio (Ohio Rescue), que ayudaron a mantener bajos los pagos de la hipoteca.

After being referred to PathStone's Homeownership Program, Treva committed to buying the first home PathStone would build in a new-home construction project in Anderson. Despite being a young mother holding down two jobs in different cities, Treva successfully completed PathStone's Homebuyer Education Program and all of the requirements to be pre-approved for a mortgage. All was going well until Treva lost her full-time job because of layoffs. Knowing she was determined to immediately find work, PathStone staff agreed to give Treva time to find another job so she could still have the home for which she already had hand-picked the lights, floor covering, appliances and siding. Treva came through with a new job and was pre-approved again by the bank after only one month at her new job. Shortly thereafter, Treva closed on her brand-new home.

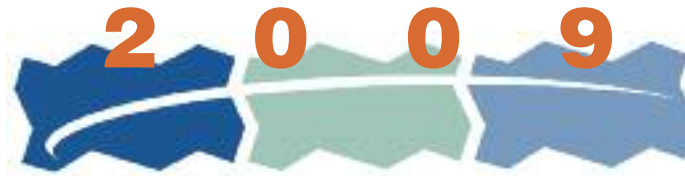
Programa de Titularidad de Hogar en Indiana

A pesar de que ella era una madre con dos trabajos en ciudades diferentes, Treva completó con éxito el Programa de Educación para Compradores de Casas de PathStone y todos los requisitos para recibir la pre-aprobación de una hipoteca. Todo le iba bien hasta que Treva perdió su trabajo de jornada completa debido a despidos. Sabiendo que ella estaba decidida a buscar trabajo inmediatamente, el personal de PathStone estuvo de acuerdo en darle tiempo a Treva para encontrar otro trabajo de manera que ella pudiera tener la casa para la cual ella ya había escogido las luces, el recubrimiento de piso, los aparatos electrodomésticos y el revestimiento exterior. 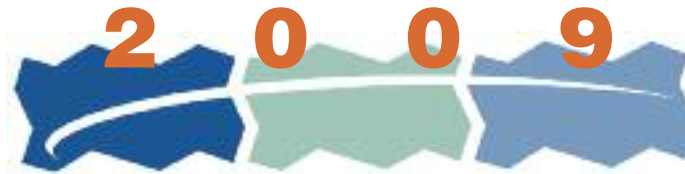
Servicios para el Manejo de la Propiedad y Residentes de Nueva York

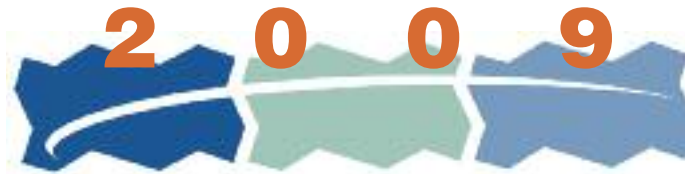
El Programa de Head Start para Emigrantes en Pennsylvania

Ohio Training & Employment Program

Priscilla Martinez walked into PathStone's Fremont office seeking food assistance. After talking with our staff, Priscilla said she wanted to learn more about our Training & Employment Program. One of Priscilla's biggest barriers was that she had never held a job outside of the fields. However, she had just obtained her GED and was interested in going to school to learn how to be a phlebotomist. Priscilla was referred to the Vanguard-Sentinel Career Center and enrolled in phlebotomy classes. PathStone provided her with an hourly stipend while she attended classes full time, as well as assistance with travel expenses, a uniform and supplies she needed to complete her clinical work at a Fremont Memorial Hospital. After receiving a certificate for completing the program, Priscilla continued working at Fremont Memorial Hospital, where she is now making \$10.80 per hour.

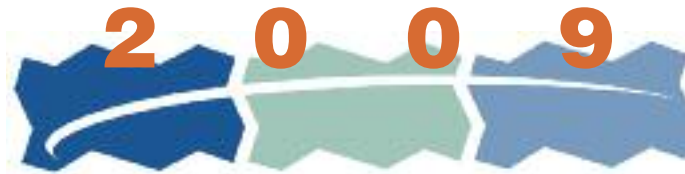
Programa de Adiestramiento & Empleo de Ohio

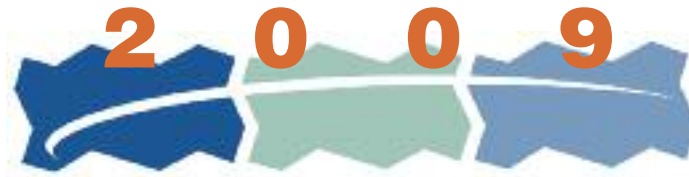
Programa de Adiestramiento & Empleo de Vermont

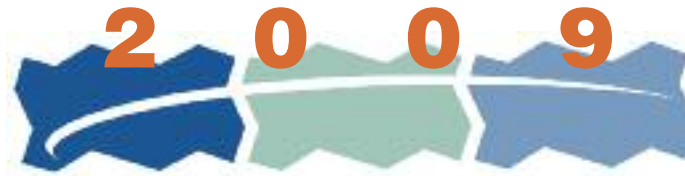
Programa de Adiestramiento & Empleo de Pennsylvania

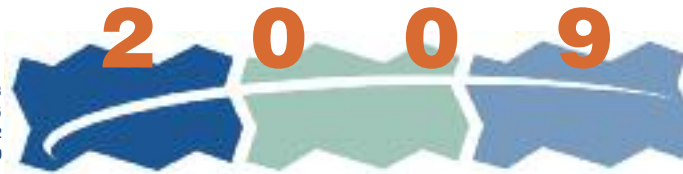
Programa de Adiestramiento & Empleo de Nueva Jersey

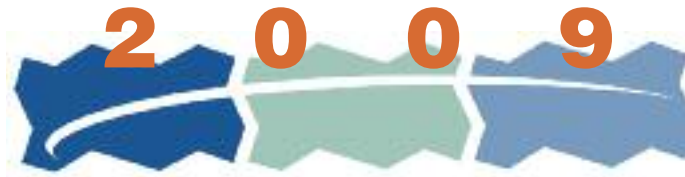
Programa de Adiestramiento & Empleo de Puerto Rico

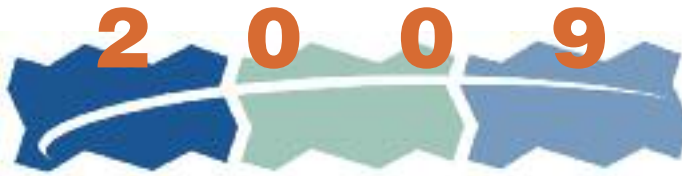

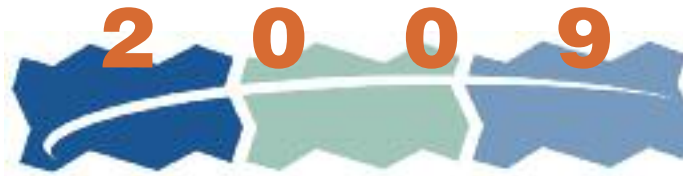
Programa de Auto- Suficiencia de la Familia de New York

Battling health issues, Roland Cook and his fiancé, Teresa, who was 6 months pregnant, had lost their apartment and found themselves homeless. Now married, the couple has welcomed the arrival of their son, Micheal Danial J. Cook, and are living in other PathStone-owned housing. Roland said he looks forward to utilizing more PathStone programs to help him "build a foundation for a life."
